

1 Kings 9: 1-5 (NASB 2020)

Now it came about when Solomon had finished building the house of the Lord and the king's house, and all that Solomon desired to do, ² that the Lord appeared to Solomon a second time, as He had appeared to him at Gibeon. ³ And the Lord said to him, "I have heard your prayer and your plea which you have offered before Me; I have consecrated this house which you have built, by putting My name there forever, and My eyes and My heart will be there always. ⁴ As for you, if you walk before Me as your father David walked, in integrity of heart and honesty, acting in accordance with everything that I have commanded you, *and if* you keep My statutes and My ordinances, ⁵ then I will establish the throne of your kingdom over Israel forever, just as I promised to your father David, saying, 'You shall not be deprived of a man on the throne of Israel.'

Even though these verses occur back to back and are part of a single conversation or monologue, I have separated them so you can see how it is possible to remember one part while forgetting the other part.

1 Kings 9: 6-9 (NASB 2020)

But if you or your sons indeed turn away from following Me, and do not keep My commandments and My statutes which I have placed before you, but you go and serve other gods and worship them, ⁷ then I will cut Israel off from the land which I have given them, and the house which I have consecrated for My name, I will expel from My sight. So Israel will become a saying and an object of derision among all peoples. ⁸ And this house will become a heap of ruins; everyone who passes by it will be appalled and hiss and say, 'Why has the Lord done such a thing to this land and this house?' ⁹ And they will say, 'Because they abandoned the Lord their God, who brought their fathers out of the land of Egypt, and they adopted other gods and worshiped and served them, for that reason the Lord has brought all this adversity on them.' "

Similar Account for reference purposes:

2 Chronicles 7:16-18 (NASB 2020)

For now I have chosen and consecrated this house so that My name may be there forever, and My eyes and My heart will be there always. ¹⁷ As for you, if you walk before Me as your father David walked, to do according to everything that I have commanded you, and keep My statutes and My ordinances, ¹⁸ then I will establish your royal throne as I covenanted with your father David, saying, 'You shall not lack a man *to be* ruler in Israel.'

2 Chronicles 7:19-22 (NASB 2020)

But if you turn away and abandon My statutes and My commandments which I have set before you, and go and serve other gods and worship them, ²⁰ then I will uproot you from My land which I have given you, and this house which I have consecrated for My name I will cast out of My sight; and I will make it a proverb and an object of scorn among all peoples. ²¹ As for this house, which was exalted, everyone who passes by it will be astonished and say, 'Why has the Lord done these things to this land and to this house?' ²² And they will say, 'Because they abandoned the Lord, the God of their fathers, who brought them from the land of Egypt, and they adopted other gods, and worshiped and served them; therefore He has brought all this adversity on them.' "

Haggai 2: 9 (NASB 2020)

'The latter glory of this house will be greater than the former,' says the Lord of armies, 'and in this place I will give peace,' declares the Lord of armies."
